



A Challenge to the Pupils of
Jersey's Primary Schools
from the
Lions Club of Jersey



Could you enter 'THE LIONS DEN' and
be one of the winners of the
LIONS ANNUAL CHARITY BURSARY
and share a fund of £3,000?

Groups of primary school pupils (up to six in a group from school-years Reception to year 6), are invited to compete for a financial award by telling the Lions Club of Jersey why they are nominating a charity of their choice to support or how they would otherwise spend charitable money awarded, for the good of the community.

Each group will be from a primary school, and give itself a name.

Teams will be asked to explain to The Lions Den judges why they have selected their chosen charity, and to demonstrate, using graphic illustrations, how well they know the charity and what it sets out to achieve. *A short list of ten entries will each receive a cash award of £100 for their nominated charity, with the winner receiving the main award. Of £2,000.*

The 2019/20 Junior Bursary main award will be payable to the designated charity chosen by the winning team. *It is important that participants show that they have researched the work of the designated charity and ideally how they anticipate the award will be spent. The main award will be made to the team showing the greatest commitment and involvement with their chosen charity.*

The Application Form must be completed giving as much detail as is reasonably possible. *If required, a member of the Lions Club of Jersey will help to give advice on completion of the application form.*

The deadline for applications for the 2019/20 award is 30th April 2020, but entries may be submitted as soon as ready.

The short-listed teams will be asked to give a short presentation to The Lions Den panel of judges, so that a winning team can be selected.
